#### 1. Job description

Primate Research Institute, Kyoto University (KUPRI) is seeking to appoint a suitable candidate to the position of Program-Specific Associate Professor for the Department of Neuroscience. The Cognitive Neuroscience Section conducts research to establish nonhuman primate models for human psychiatric disorders without gene modification elucidating its brain dysfunction (Grant-in-Aid for Scientific Research (A)). The Department endeavors to establish such models using macaque monkeys and common marmosets. A person who has knowledge and experience of studies of social behavior including communicative behavior in macaques and marmosets is preferable.
